Third Sunday in Lent March 24, 2019

Marriages: This great sacrament of vocation is a joyous time, but also a time of very serious spiritual preparation. The responsibility assumed by the couple and the Church is significant. While many focus on the day of the wedding, we seek to prepare for the second day and beyond. The Bishops of NJ have adopted a policy to assist in this preparation. Attendance at Engaged Encounter, Pre-Cana, or another approved marriage prep program, and individual sessions with a priest or deacon are required of all couples. Couples should contact the Rectory one year in advance of the intended marriage, and before finalizing other detail particularly reception facilities.

Baptisms: The Church shares the joy of families in the birth of children, and, with their parents takes seriously the responsibility of bringing them up in the faith. Parents seeking baptism for their children are to attend Baptismal Prep Class. This can be arranged by calling the parish office. Parents should be registered members of the parish. Godparents, those who represent the church in the life of the child, must be practicing Catholics, if they are married, they must have been married in the Church, practice the faith regularly, and must obtain a sponsor certificate from their home parish. Please choose Godparents with these criteria in mind.

Anointing of the Sick: This sacrament is given for those facing serious illness or surgery, and for those of advanced years. If you or a family member is planning to enter the hospital, please see one of the priests following Mass or call the rectory if you would like to receive this sacrament.

From Father Doug:

I heard on Catholic Radio, Father John Riccardo to be exact, that the way to evaluate the effectiveness of a parish's ministry is whether or not people leave feeling loved. It was a perspective I had never considered before. Certainly if attending the Sacrament of Penance, we hope that the overwhelming sense is that of being loved and forgiven by God. Sadly, some people have memories of less than loving receptions in the confessional. I hope that has changed, at least that is what I try to reflect as a confessor. People should leave the confessional feeling deeply loved, and restored to right relationship with God, self, and others.

In the celebration of Holy Mass, receiving Christ: Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, God giving Himself to us completely is the most profound act of love imaginable. God giving Himself to us each as if we were His only child. In time spent in adoration of our Blessed Lord we spend intimate and loving time with Jesus. That is why I hope that you will take part at least for even a few moments of adoration on March 28 and 30 at Sacred Heart for 24 Hours for the Lord.

But that still leaves another aspect of peoples' experience in our parishes. Do people feel loved by us, by the community of faith. Often visitors feel ignored, they feel that their presence among the faithful at Holy Mass is not even noticed. The theme for the 24 Hours for the Lord is Compassion. We should all be asking how do our parishes reflect compassion and love to even the person wandering through, or more importantly those sticking a toe in the water to see if they have a place among the faithful.

So we ask for ourselves and the visitors among us, do we feel loved in our experience at Mass, and if not, what can we do to change that?

MID-LENT CHECK-IN

God says to Moses, "This is what you shall tell the Israelites: I AM sent me to you . . . The LORD, the God of your [ancestors], the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, the God of Jacob" (Exodus 3:14, 15). As Jesus would later say, God is not a God of the dead, but of the living, and so we believe that the dead will one day rise. At this midpoint of Lent, we pause to consider how our repentance is leading us to the Resurrection, to our reunion with the great "I AM." Part of our repentance involves working to secure justice for all and helping our neighbor to live in God's ways. We encourage each other and nurture each other, like the compassionate gardener of today's Gospel, who tells the owner of the orchard that he will nurture the tree, fertilize it, and perhaps it will bear fruit.
